Reader's Workshop

This week your child will take a practice FCAT test (I will share results with you as soon as I have them). We will also review compare and contrast and I will continue the "winter" DRAs.

Writer's Workshop

This week we will continue to work on the procedural/functional writing (how to) genre.

Skills Block

This week the students will continue to work with their spelling words for our January 17th spelling test. We will continue learning a few more lowercase cursive letters.

Math

This week we will continue our geometry and measurement unit. We will focus on combining and separating shapes and making new shapes. Vocab knowledge is a MUST for this!

This week we will continue our timed multiplication quizzes. Please look over your child's quiz from last week. If he/she scored a 100% it is time to move on to the next set of facts (3s), if not then the previous set of facts (2s) will need more work.
