Reader's Workshop

This week we will continue working with context clues to help us infer the meaning of unknown words. We will also take our first unit test, which will be comprised of everything that we have learned this year. Some of the skills include, but are not limited to, guide words, multiple meaning words and of course our previous reading strategies. This will be an excellent gauge of how well your child has learned and retained the skills and strategies so far this year.

Writer's Workshop

This week we will look at the writing standards and create our writing rubric. The students will use the rubric that they help create to decide whether or not their writing is "good enough."

Skills Block

This week the students will get their next set of *Words their Way* spelling words for their November 2nd spelling test. We will also discuss our new word of the week and work with the prefixes un- (meaning not) and re- (meaning again).

Math

This week we will continue to work with multiplication and finding factors with arrays. This will be the perfect transition into division, which is next on our list. The students have already gotten some practice with division when we solved the missing factor story problems. As we work through division the students will be encouraged to find a strategy that works best for them.

Science

Last week we focused on stars and the students even had an opportunity to make their own constellations. This week our learning will be focused on the sun. It's a hot topic!
