If the answer is taken, lose your turn. Have fun!

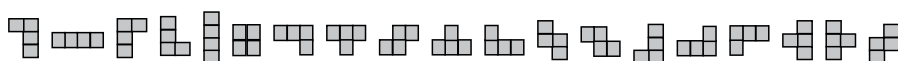
